COMPONENTS OF A SECURITY SYSTEM

- **Human factor**
- **Mechanical components (gates, fences, barriers...)**
- **Electrical components (electromagnetic locks, lighting equipment...)**
- **Electronic components (security camera systems, alarm systems...)**

MAIN DIFFERENCES OF SECURITY SOLUTIONS BETWEEN WESTERN AND EASTERN APPROACH

- Possible threats are divided into higher risk threats and lower priority threats
- Strong emphasis on high-tech in security issues
- All threats have the same priority (the highest priority)
- Protection of life and health has higher priority than protection of property
- Strong emphasis on the human factor in security issues – trainings, drills, security thinking

MAIN SECURITY CHALLENGES IN SLOVAK REPUBLIC

- **Protection of life**
- **Protection of health**
- **Protection of property**

SECURE FUTURE

- **Unification of Western and Eastern approach to security**
- **Create a global chain of security**

MAIN SECURITY PROBLEMS OF ZSSK:

- **Vandalism**
- **Verbal and physical aggression towards train personnel and passengers**
- **Suicides**
