As part of a series of attractiveness measures targeted at universities and railway undertakings, the UIC is launching its first global Rail Hackathon. The **European region Hackathon** is organised by the Mechanical Engineering Department of the University of Malaga within the frame of the ASTONRAIL Erasmus+ Project.



Thematic: How can railways be resilient in the face of pandemics?

This Hackathon offers participants and rail enthusiasts the opportunity to imagine the future and develop solutions for railway operators to better face pandemic situations. The hackathon will include various themes and activities, such as: training, customer service on board trains and in stations, maintenance workshops, management of suspicious cases, communication and information, etc.

A European regional “ON-LINE competition” will be held on the 26th of November, 2021 (it will be jointly organised with the ASTONRail project team and outreach activities in Ziline, Slovakia), with a final contest at international level in May 2022, in the frame of the World Congress about Rail Training, Talent and Development (WCRT) in Moscow.
